If you have a passion for fashion, theatre and costume design, the Royal Opera House in Thurrock has a great opportunity for you. On Friday 12 June, a special Inspiration Day with an emphasis on costume is taking place at the Royal Opera House Bob and Tamar Manoukian Production Workshop on High House Production Park in Purfleet.

This Inspiration Day offers participants a hands-on Costume Workshop with experienced costume designer and maker **Amanda Hall**. The workshop will be based on Gluck's popular opera *Orfeo ed Euridice*, due to appear on the main stage at the Royal Opera House in Covent Garden this autumn.

It will explore characterization through costume, analyzing visual stereotypes such as good and bad characters and defining visual clues that audiences might expect to see and read easily in their costumes.



No experience needed, just enthusiasm and an interest in finding out more about our costume department. Costumes from the Royal Opera House store in Thurrock will also be available on the day to handle and even try on..

The Inspiration Day also includes a tour of the **Bob and Tamar Manoukian Production Workshop** to see the craftspeople at work and an opportunity to see some of the Royal Opera House's many on-line and virtual resources about costume.

The Inspiration Day begins at 10.30am and ends at 3pm. Spaces are very limited and booking is essential. The cost including lunch is £30 or £25 for those under 18.
