

Voices of the Future

Overview

Voices of the Future is an 18-month programme of professional development opportunities for teachers who are interested in gaining skills and confidence as singing leaders. It supports teachers to use singing to teach and inspire their pupils, colleagues and the whole school community. Although we ask schools to cover the cost of releasing teachers for six days over 18 months, participating in the programme is otherwise **free!**



What does the course involve?

Voices of the Future consists of six INSET days, in-school mentoring sessions and a sharing performance. Course participants have opportunities to work towards goals tailored to the needs of themselves and their schools. We plan to focus on a broad range of topics, including confidence, rehearsing and leading songs, healthy and top-quality singing, acting and movement, and how singing can support music and the wider curriculum.



Who can apply?

The programme is for any teacher working in Havering with enthusiasm for, interest in or curiosity in developing their teaching practice through singing. We're particularly keen to collaborate with teachers working with years 5-8. We expect some participants to be music specialists and others to be generalists with an interest in music and singing.
