# **Woolf Works**

Virginia Woolf defied the false order of narrative conventions to depict a heightened, startling and poignant reality. *Woolf Works* re-creates the synaesthetic collision of form and substance in her writings.

Each of the three acts springs from one of Woolf's landmark novels: *Mrs Dalloway*, *Orlando* and *The Waves* – but these inspirations are also enmeshed with elements from her letters, essays and diaries. *Woolf Works* expresses the heart of an artistic life driven to discover a freer, uniquely modern realism, and brings to life Woolf's world of 'granite and rainbow', where human beings are at once both physical body and uncontained essence. *Woolf Works*, created in 2015, was Wayne McGregor's first full-length work for The Royal Ballet.
